In the early 1970s, teenagers with disabilities faced a future shaped by isolation, discrimination and institutionalization. Camp Jened, a ramshackle camp in Catskills, was a place of liberation with summertime sports, smoking and make-out sessions where campers experienced full inclusion as human beings. It is this

same place that ignited progressive activism and inspired campers to join the fight for disability civil rights.



Co-directed by Emmy®-winning filmmaker Nicole Newnham and former camper Jim LeBrecht, this exuberant documentary arrives the same year as the 30th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Crip Camp is also executive produced by President Barack Obama and Michelle Obama.
